ABSTRACT

The objectives of this article were to create to implement and to evaluate the management model for development to quality schools of Ban Khonkeannonsawan school under the Loei Primary Educational Service Area Office 2 by 3 steps of research developmentmethodology; (1) creating the management model by literature reviewing, the scholars interview, drafting the models' suitability and feasibility assessment by 7 the academic experts. The data were collected by interviewing and questionnaires. (2) experimenting the management model in the first semester of academic year 2020 by 20 teachers and 190 students. The research tools were the model manual, questionnaires and summary form. (3) evaluating the management model. The data was collected from 9 teachers by questionnaire. The statistics used for data analysis were mean and standard deviation. The finding showed as follow: (1) The management model for development to quality schools of Ban Khonkeannonsawan school under the Loei Primary Educational Service Area Office 2 consist of 6 elements; (a) Principle, (b) objectives, (c) 7 quality school elements (d) 7 steps of the management process (e) outputs and (f) success factors and the management model's suitability and feasibility in overall were the highest level. (2) The implement results the management model showed the self-assessment based on the quality school elements was high level, the students had higher academic achievement than academic year 2019 and the stakeholders' satisfaction in overall were the highest level (= 4.76, S.D.=0.04). (3) The evaluation results of the management model for development to quality schools of Ban Khonkeannonsawan school under the Loei Primary Educational Service Area Office 2 in feasibility standards, Utility standards and propriety standards were the highest level 4 . 66 , S . 1. INTRODUCTION

In addition, the learning achievement recording form for collecting the students' learning achievement. A school quality assessment form also used for self-evaluation of the school quality. The Another tool was rating scale questionnaire for stakeholders' satisfaction. All tools were inspected the content validity and reliability that indicated the quality of psychometric property.

2.3 Procedure and design

This research is research and development. The research was divided into 3 steps as follows:

Step 1 Creating a management model to develop into a quality school of Ban Khonkaennonsawan school Loei Primary Educational Service Area Office 2. The researcher conducted a study and analyzed the content of the study concepts, theories and related documents, such as the concept of educational reform at the basic education institution level, quality school concept, the concept of a good school district Sub-district, quality school concept international standard school concept and interviews were conducted with 7 qualified persons, to give opinions in conducting research to improve the quality of the studies, then analyze them for concordance and draw conclusions together and to draft a management model to develop into a quality school of Ban Khon Kaen Non Sawan School. The next step was presenting the draft model to 7 experts and experts, which were obtained by choosing a specific model and conducting group discussion sessions to assess the appropriateness and feasibility of the model and bring various issues to improve the management model to develop into a quality school of Ban Khon Kaen Non Sawan School.

Step 3: Assessing the management model by stake holders using the satisfaction questionnaire and the evaluation form by experts.

2.4 Data analysis

The statistics used in the data analysis were percentage, mean, standard deviation. and content analysis. The quantitative data was analyzed by percentage, mean, standard deviation while the qualitative data was analyzed by content analysis.
